Granite Benchtops

- Granite is porous, the stone surfaces must be wiped down after every use.
- If a spill or grease stain occurs it must be wiped straight away.
- Clean regularly with soapy water only and avoid abrasives, thinners or strong chemical agents for cleaning as they will remove the protective sealer.
- Periodically or when required, reapply sealer to the granite for protection.
- See the Care & Maintenance Guide for recommended cleaning and stain removal products.

Stainless Steel Appliances

- Stainless steel is prone to discolouration when exposed to the elements.
- Clean regularly to retain an appearance free of blemishes or stains.
- Consider your location ie. coastal areas, humidity and frost can produce moisture and salt. More frequent cleaning might be required.
- With beverage coolers be aware of condensation that can occur on the front.
- For general cleaning use a soft cloth with soapy water only and towel dry.

BENCHTOPS - Granite

Granite is a hard but porous stone. Variation in colour, grain, structure and veining is to be expected. Small holes, pot marks, fine cracks, crystals and imperfections are common in many granite colours and are unavoidable. Different granites come in varying slab sizes and as such joints in benchtops may be unavoidable.

Care & Maintenance Tips

- Always clean spills as soon as possible.
- To maintain your benchtops use soapy water and a soft cloth only to clean.
- Avoid abrasive products, thinners or strong chemical agents for cleaning as they can cause damage to the surface and remove the protective sealer.
- To avoid cracking, do not place hot items directly on the stone surface. Use trivets or mats under hot items to prevent this.
- Do not sit or stand on granite benchtops particularly at weak points such as overhangs and cut-outs.
- We recommend sealing the stone benchtops every 12 months to keep from staining. If staining has occurred then take quick action with a recommend stone stain removal product, clean with soapy water and always reseal the tops afterwards.

CABINETRY - Doors and Panels, Cabinets, Hinges and Drawers

Doors and Panels are made using a durable, lightweight extruded aluminium frame with a water and UV resistant composite aluminium insert panel. Cabinets are made from a lightweight PVC foam material with waterproof properties. Hinges are made from 304 grade stainless steel and the drawers are galvanized with a high wearing powder coat finish.

Care & Maintenance Tips

Doors, Panels and Cabinets

- Routine cleaning of the surfaces is recommended.

- Use water and mild detergent with a damp soft cloth or sponge (not an abrasive sponge or steel wool), followed by a clean water rinse and towel dry.
- Do not clean surfaces heated by the sun (>40°) – the quick-drying process may cause blemishes.
- Do not use abrasives, solvent-based or cream cleansers.

Hinges and Drawers

- Routine cleaning of the surfaces is recommended.
- Clean drawers using water and mild detergent with a damp soft cloth or sponge (not an abrasive sponge or steel wool), followed by a clean water rinse and towel dry.
- Clean hinges with a dry soft cloth but you must ensure the cloth does not contain any moisture. Hinges are specially protected by a thin high-grade oil film that ensures its functionality and durability.
- Do not use abrasives, solvent-based or cream cleansers.
- Do not use lubricants such as oils or grease.
- It is essential for all stainless steel products to be cleaned on a regular basis to preserve the finish and prevent staining.
- Drawer runners and hinges must be free from grime and dirt to allow best performance and smooth mechanical use.

Galvanized and Powder-Coated Frames

Frames are made from two types of materials. The fascias consist of a hot-dipped zinc sheet material that is then powder-coated in a high UV resistant finish. The frames and components are hot-dipped galvanized steel, which gives protection from the elements.

Care & Maintenance Tips

Fascias and Frames

- Routine cleaning of the surfaces is recommended.
- Use water and mild detergent with a damp soft cloth or sponge (not an abrasive sponge or steel wool), followed by a clean water rinse and towel dry.
- Do not clean surfaces heated by the sun (>40°) – the quick-drying process may cause blemishes.
- Do not use abrasives, solvent-based or cream cleansers.

Stainless Steel Components, BBQ and Beverage Coolers

The BBQ and beverage coolers come in a selection of stainless steel and enamel finishes. Care and maintenance steps must be followed to prevent harm from the elements that may create imperfections or staining on the products.

Care & Maintenance Tips

Stainless Steel Products

- A BBQ cover is recommended to help preserve the BBQ exterior.
- It is essential for all stainless steel products to be cleaned on a regular basis to preserve the finish and prevent staining. Use soapy water and a soft cloth only to clean before towel drying.
- Use a stainless steel oil polish to preserve the finish, add protection and preventing staining – always rub in the direction of the grain/finish lines. It is recommended that this is applied every 3 months and after cleaning.
- Do not use abrasives, solvent-based or cream cleaners.
- The harsher the environment or exposure to the elements, the more frequent your cleaning regime would need to be.
- If staining does occur then use a quality stainless steel cleaner as per the manufacturer's instructions. Always rub in the stainless steel grain/finish direction to prevent scratches. Always reapply the stainless oil polish after the cleaner has been used.

Care & Maintenance Tips

Enamel BBQ and Powder Coated Beverage Cooler

- A BBQ cover is recommended to help preserve and reduce cleaning of the BBQ exterior.
- Routine cleaning of the surfaces is recommended.
- Use water and mild detergent with a damp soft cloth or sponge (not an abrasive sponge or steel wool), followed by a clean water rinse and towel dry.
- Do not clean surfaces heated by the sun (>40°) – the quick-drying process may cause blemishes.
- Do not use abrasives, solvent-based or cream cleansers.

IMPORTANT!

- The BBQ appliance is made for outdoor use only. It is not suitable for indoor use of any kind. Routine cleaning of all surfaces is required in accordance with the manufactures guidelines.
- A Beverage Cooler is an electrical appliance and particular care must be taken to avoid direct contact with water. Routine cleaning of all surfaces is required in accordance with the manufactures guidelines. It is suitable for Beverages ONLY (This is not a fridge) and must be sheltered from the elements (Suitable for outdoor under cover use only).
